

## WHITE WINE

### **Lesc, Vin de Pays du Gers – Gascony, France (2010/11)**

Light, extremely fruity and refreshing blend of Ugni blanc and Colombard.  
Bottle - £15.50    Glass (175ml) - £4.50

### **Pinot Grigio, Borgo SanLeo-Delle Venezie, Italy (2010/11)**

Light, pale and fruity. Bottle - £17.95

### **Chenin Blanc, Good Hope – Stellenbosch, South Africa (2010/11)**

Fresh pineapple and honey with a lovely acidity and a fresh mineral finish.  
Bottle - £19.95    Glass (175ml) - £5.50

### **Viognier, Villa Vieja – Mendoza, Argentina (2011)**

Typically golden wine with warm white flesh fruits and mangoes and hints of white flowers. In the mouth, this wine is nicely balanced with plenty of fruit, but also a certain freshness. Bottle - £22.50

### **Picpoul De Pinet, Domaine de la Mirande - Languedoc, France (2010)**

This version has a spicy aniseed bouquet, green fruits and herbs, is quite resinous with an ample mouth feel and savoury flavours of iodine, yellow plum and pepper, also a sharp prickle. Bottle – £23.50

### **Sauvignon blanc, Framingham – Marlborough, New Zealand (2011)**

Lovely elderflower and green fig nose with an attractive, yet smooth palate showing characteristics passion fruit flavours. Bottle - £27.95    Glass (175ml) - £6.95

### **Gavi di Tassarolo la Fornace, AA Cinzia Bergaglio – Piedmont, Italy (2010/11)**

Really fresh and floral, clean with a pleasant aftertaste of toasted almond and hints of apple and sage.  
Bottle - £28.50

### **Chablis, Domaine Gérard Tremblay – Burgundy, France (2010/11)**

Deep colour, with a mineral attack that develops into spring blossom, lemon, smoke and almonds.  
Bottle - £30.50

### **Sancerre la vigne blanche, Henri Bourgeois – Loire Valley, France (2010/11)**

Vinous, with herbaceous notes of elderflower and ivy, and a hint of kiwi fruit. Bottle - £32.95

### **Rias Baixas O Rosal, Bodegas Terras Gauda – Galicia, Spain (2009/10)**

Greenish-yellow, evoking white flowers and green plums on the nose and filling out on the palate with fresh grape and apple compote flavours as well as peach kernel. Edged with superb acidity and a bristling minerality this is reminiscent of a really good Riesling. Bottle - £34.95

### **Puligny-Montrachet, Louis Latour – Burgundy, France (2008)**

A dazzling golden coloured wine, the Puligny-Montrachet exudes smoky aromas and grilled nuts alongside notes of peaches and apricots. On the palate this fatty, ample wine recalls white fruits. Bottle - £55.00

## ROSE WINE

### **Pinot Grigio Blush, Ramato, Italy (2010/11)**

The Zonin family established through out Italy since 1921, and have since developed a reputation for consistency and quality in their approach to viticulture. This blush Pinot Grigio is perfect for a warm summers day, this wine is light and fresh on the palate with attractive floral aromas. Bottle - £23.95.  
Glass (175ml) - £5.95

### **Côtes de Provence Elégance T & C Carteron – Provence France (2010/11)**

The blend of the rose is 40% Grenache, 50% Cinsault, 10% Syrah. The colour is the spirit of Provence, pale, crystalline and limpid. The nose is pretty, unveiling floral aromas of bergamot and sweet jasmine as well as bouquet of exotic and red berry fruits, whilst the palate picks up notes of mango and lychee with a more savoury edge of peach-stone and citrus. Bottle – 24.95

### **Sancerre Rosé, Domaine Bonnard – Loire Valley, France (2010)**

A light, elegant, pink from Sancerre, very fresh on the palate, ideal for those summer days. Bottle - £29.95
